

RULES FOR THE LEAGUE SEASON 2009 - 10

1. Pupils are only allowed to play in their own age group.
2. This year we will be using a sin bin of 5 or 10 minutes. This can be used by a referee to allow students a 'calming down' period or for students who swear at another student. If a member of staff i/c a team feels a student is causing a problem please substitute him before the referee has to intervene!
3. If a player is sent off in a game he will not be allowed to play in the next game. This is the responsibility of the team manager. If he does the result will be forfeit.
4. All bookings and sending offs must be sent to Phil McVittie as soon as possible.
5. All schools must provide adequate first aid equipment and access to a phone for emergencies.
6. It is the responsibility of the home team to risk assess the playing surface.
7. You are allowed 5 substitutes and can use them in a role on role off method when the ball is out of play.
8. 3 points for a win 1 for a score draw. If two teams finish level on points then positions will be decided on goal difference, then goals scored and if still a tie then result against each other. In Year 8 -10 the bottom team in Division 1 will be relegated and the top team in Division 2 will be promoted.
9. Each school must appoint a member of staff i/c Football. They need to be aware of the nights other team managers are available to play home and away fixtures..
10. If a fixture has to be arranged at a later date the home team must provide their opponents with 3 suitable dates to play games.
11. All games must be played with the correct equipment – size of ball, corner flags and goal nets.
12. Play by dates are not optional.
13. Finals for Year 7 will be played at neutral venue or with agreement by staff at one of the finalist's home grounds.
